## uEducateUs ~ Are you logging in?

uEducateUs is used at both our ELC and School and not only stores student data but also handles attendance, absences, reports, important announcements, allows communication between teachers and parents and much more.

## SCHOOL HOURS 9.00AM — 3.30PM

We would like your child to arrive at school between 8.45am—8.55am.

Children are supervised in the school grounds by a staff member from 8.45am. Children are not encouraged to be at school before this time unless they are attending Breakfast Club.

#### Arriving at school on time:

- This ensures students do not miss out on important learning instructions and activities scheduled early in the day.
- Students learn the importance of punctuality and routine.
- Gives students time to greet their friends before class.
- Reduces classroom disruption for other students.

#### Late Arrivals:

Students who arrive to school after the bell MUST present to the office for a late pass before heading to class. Parents / carers must sign students in/out via the uEducateUs Kiosk.

#### Wednesday Morning Staff Briefing:

Please note that ALL Teaching and Support Staff are in a briefing every Wednesday before school with the exception of staff supervising Breakfast Club.

This briefing is finished in time for 8.45am student supervision.

#### After School - Students must be picked from school up at 3.30pm.

Please ring the office if you are running late for pick up.

Staff are on duty after school until 3.45pm. After this time teachers are often in meetings, planning for the following day etc.

Children who are still at school at 3.45pm are taken to the office to be supervised until parents pick them up.

# Safety Tips Around Our School & ELC



Please make sure your child is crossing the road at the Supervised Crossing <u>before</u> and <u>after school.</u>

- ⇒ Adhere to the 40kmph speed limit at ALL times.
- ⇒ Always drop-off or pick-up your child from suitable and legal parking spots, even if this means walking further away from school.
- ⇒ Never double park. Double parking creates poor visibility for other vehicles and children.
- ⇒ Never park across or too close to the pedestrian crossing. Adhere to parking signs.
- ⇒ Do not park across the driveways or our neighbouring houses.
- ⇒ Never perform a U-turn in close proximity to the school or ELC.
- $\Rightarrow$  Make sure all children in the car use the footpath-side door (safety door) when getting in and out of a car.
- ⇒ We encourage families to use the 'bus bay' as a quick drop off and pick up area.
- ⇒ Be extra cautious as young children can be unpredictable and difficult to see.
